Safe Patient Handling

- **Goal:**
 - To support hospitals' efforts to reduce the rate of musculoskeletal injuries related to patient handling activity.
- **Approach:**
 - NYSPFP will provide SPH education and best practice sharing opportunities to improve safety for both patients and workers. NYSPFP will support hospitals' efforts to:
 - Ensure that hospital-specific SPH goals and objectives align with hospitals' existing safety initiatives.
 - Ensure integration with hospitals' teamwork and communication efforts by focusing on the intersection of worker safety and reducing patient harm.
 - Align internal SPH activities with the New York State SPH law requirements.



Worker Safety/Safe Patient Handling - Outcome Measure

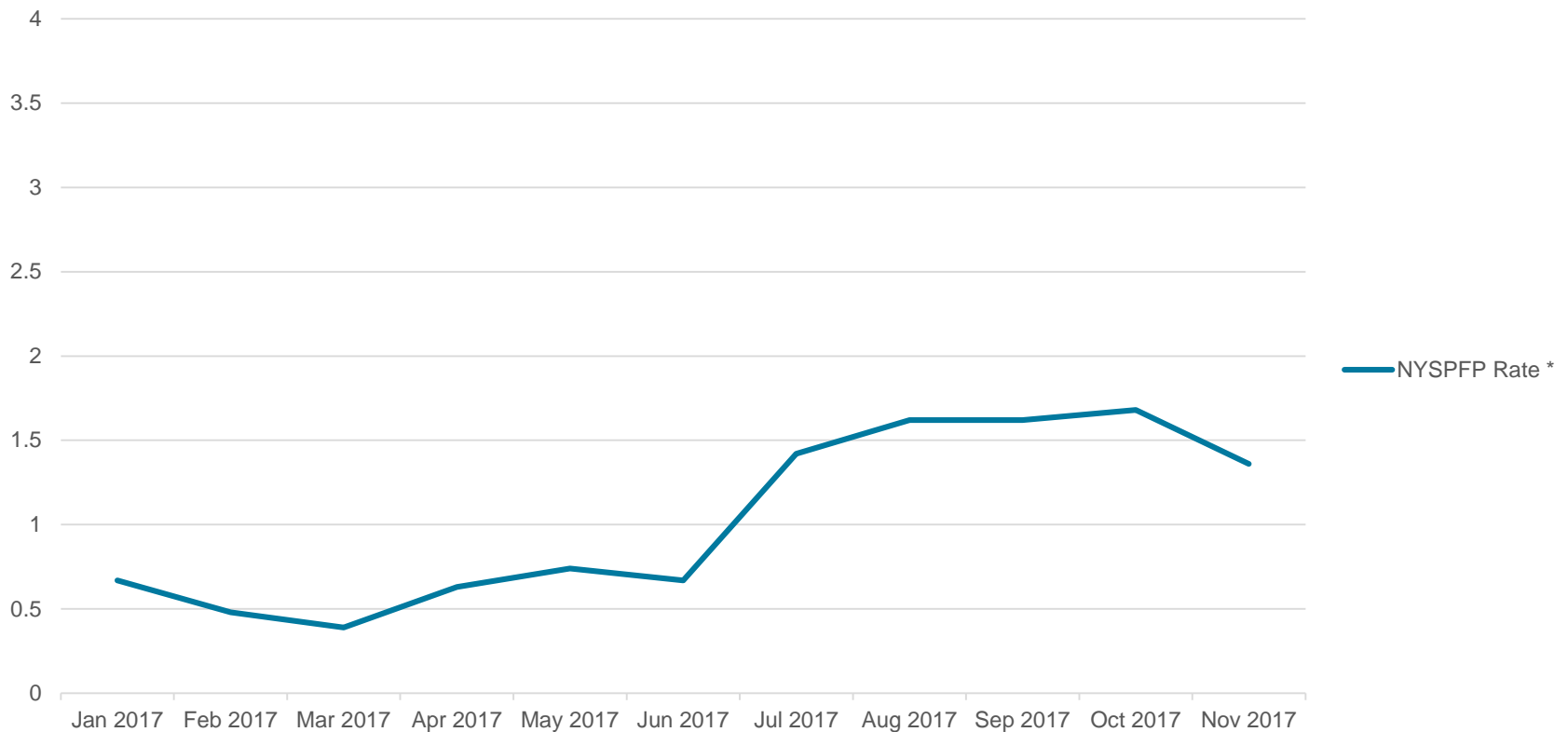
- Musculoskeletal injuries from patient handling activity per 100 direct care providers
 - **Numerator:** Number of musculoskeletal injuries from patient handling activities among direct care providers
 - **Denominator:** Total hours worked by direct care providers

$$(\text{Numerator} * 200,000) / \text{Denominator}$$



Safe Patient Handling Outcome Measure

Musculoskeletal injuries from patient handling activity per 100 direct care providers



* Approximately 30 Hospitals Submitting Data



Data Portal Entry

- Unique opportunity for members to compare their SPH/WS data with other members participating in NYSPFP program
- Data Submission Method:
 - Hospital-specific data entry into NYSPFP data collection portal by hospital-assigned data entry contact person
- Data Submission Time Period:
 - Monthly – the 15th of each month
- Data Submission Deadline:
 - Submit data to NYSPFP within 45 days
- Data Entry Tutorial Available at NYSPFP.org
