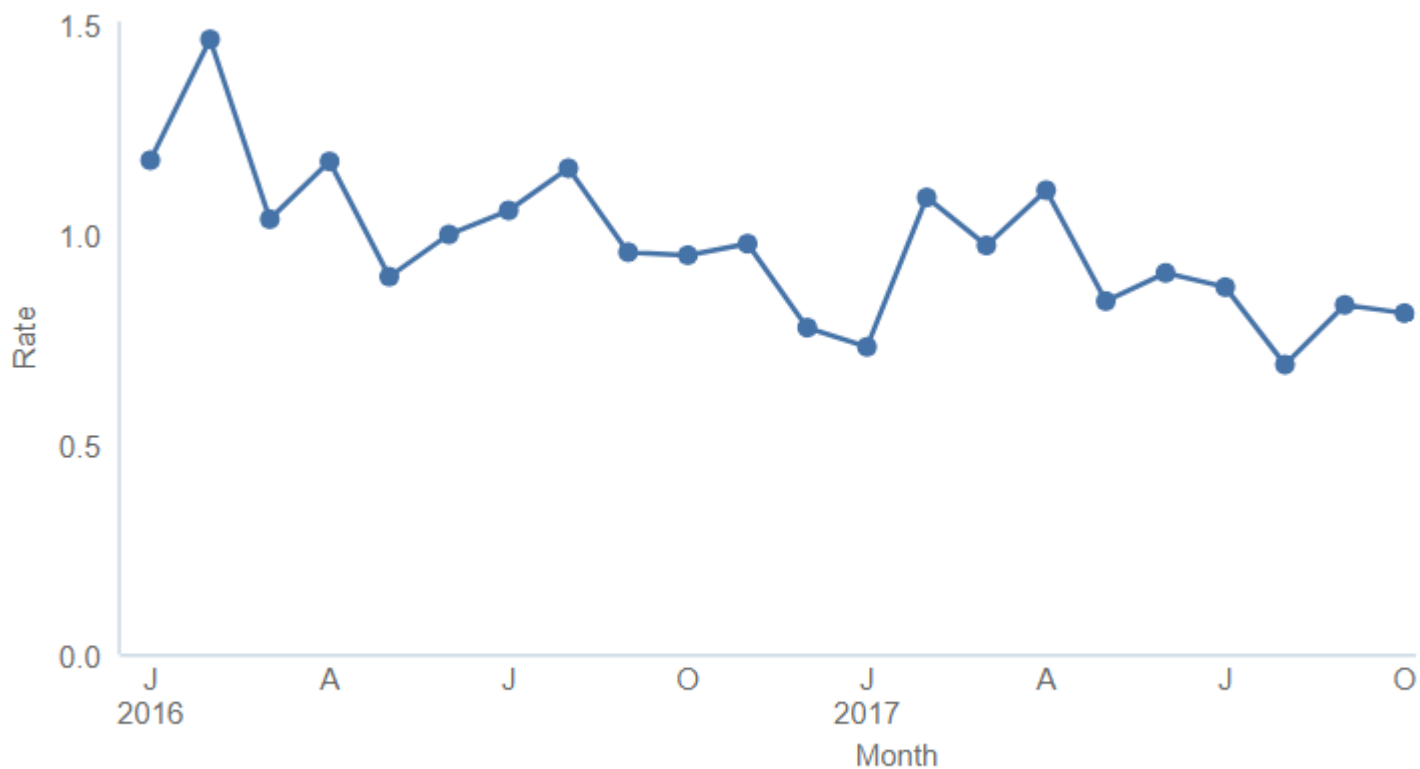
- Goal

Naloxone Doses Administered

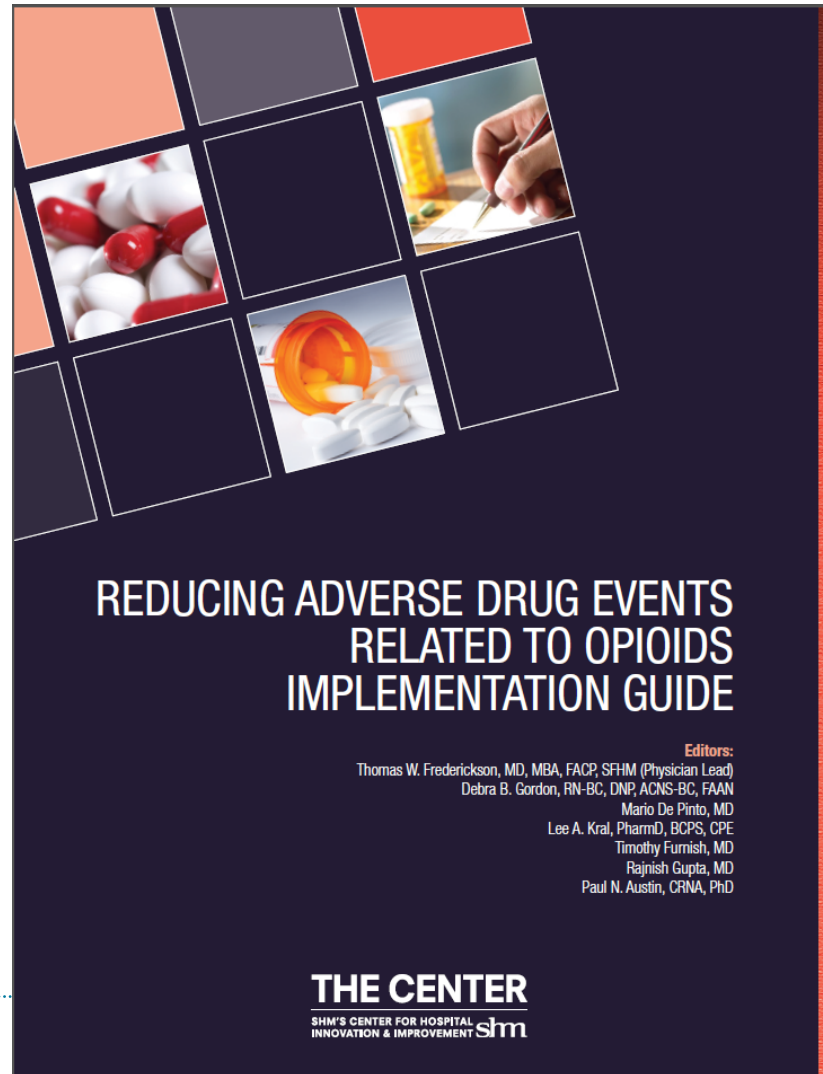
Rate of opioid reversal agent administration on inpatient care units per 1,000 patient days
