Why Sepsis Readmissions?

- Sepsis diagnoses are a current leading cause of readmissions
- Readmission after an index admission for sepsis accounts for more than 21% of all readmissions
 - That is 1 in 5 readmissions
- Increased length of stay and higher mortality rates for patients readmitted post sepsis diagnosis
- Increasing incidence of readmissions of sepsis survivors is an emerging area in patient safety that warrants exploration
