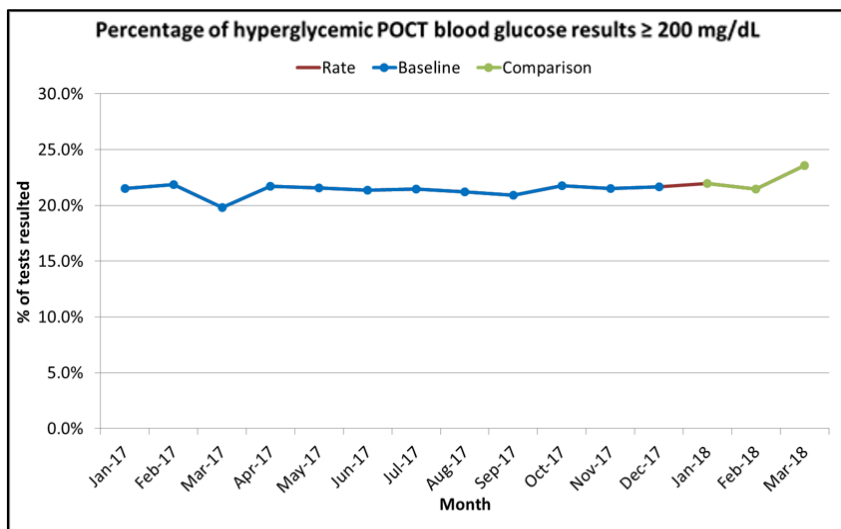

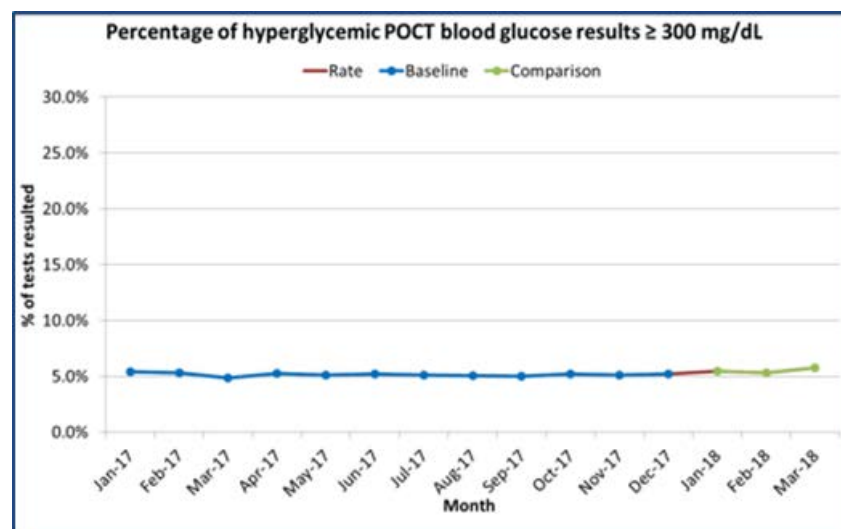

Blood glucose ≥ 200 mg/dL



BG ≥ 200 mg/dL ADE Rate	Baseline 1/17-12/17	Number Reporting	Comparison Period 1/18-3/18	Number Reporting	% Improvement
Non-rural hospital cohort	21.32	102	22.22	87	-4.18 ↓

Blood glucose ≥ 300 mg/dL

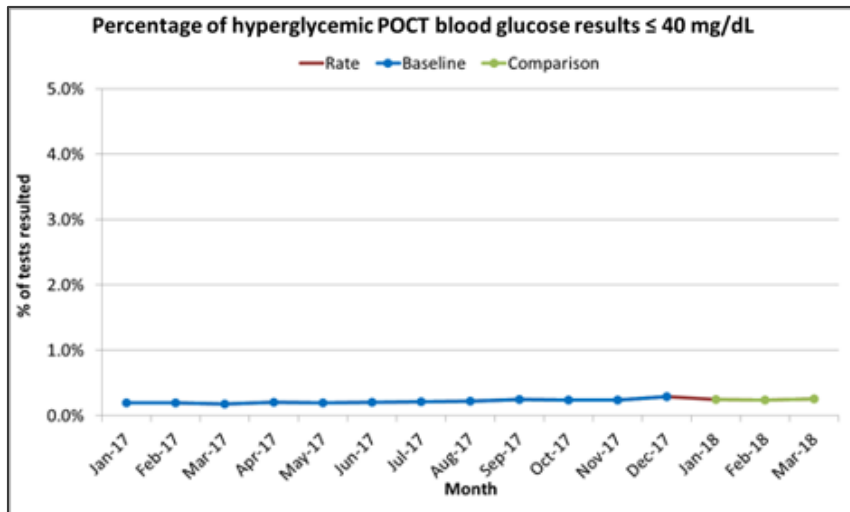


BG ≥ 300 mg/dL ADE Rate	Baseline 1/17-12/17	Number Reporting	Comparison Period 1/18-3/18	Number Reporting	% Improvement
Non-rural hospital cohort	5.15	101	5.48	86	-6.50 ↓



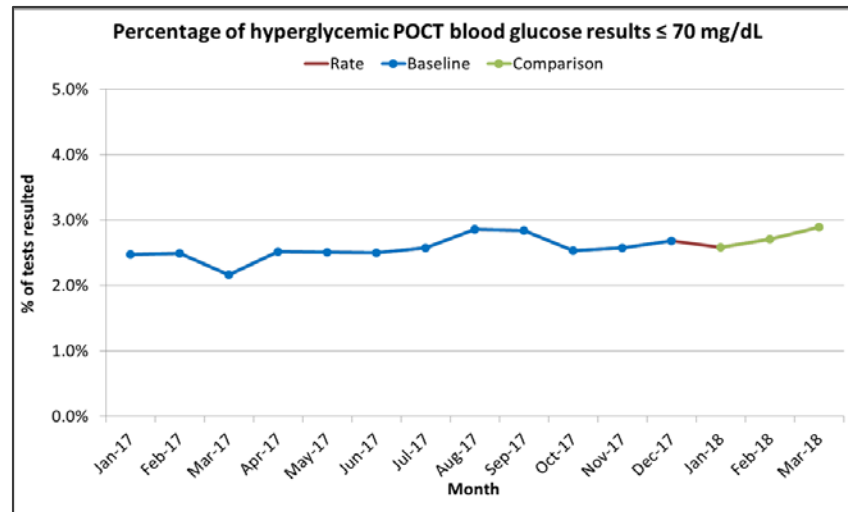

Blood glucose ≤ 70 mg/dL

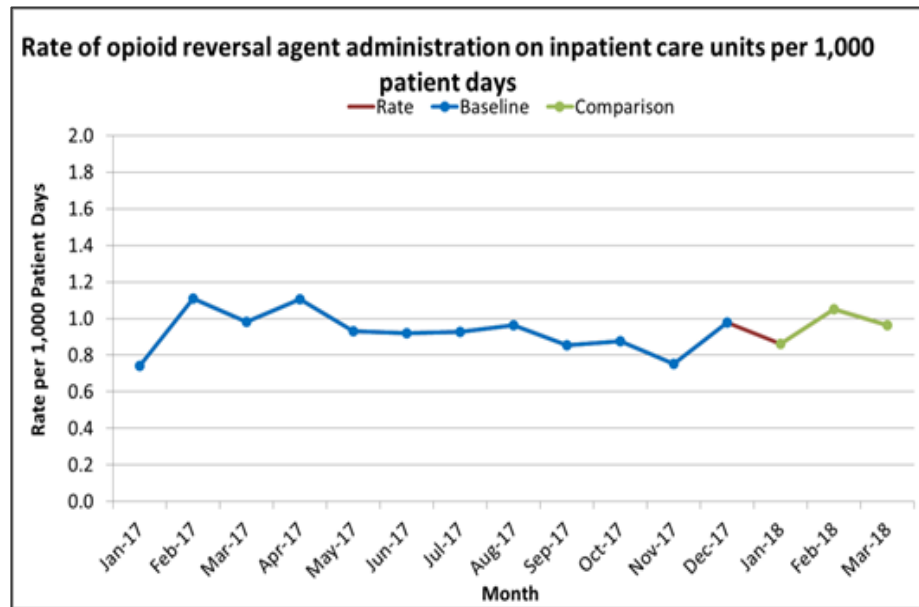

Non-rural hospital cohort	2.55	101	2.71	87	-6.29 ↓
