New EQIC special data reports available for health equity and multiple-admission patients

EQIC is pleased to announce the release of our updated special data reports on health equity and multiple-admission patients. These hospital-specific reports are available on the [secure data portal](#) under “Special Reports.”

Health equity

These reports provide the following information on the communities your hospital serves and in which areas potential improvement in data quality could be made:

- race, ethnicity, sex and age group reporting at your hospital;
- language and limited English proficiency from within your census catchment area; and
- comparisons of race and ethnicity data from your hospital-submitted claims data with census data from the geographical area where patients treated at your hospital live.

Data sources include the American Community Survey from 2017-2021 population estimates by demographic characteristics and hospital-submitted inpatient claims data from April 1, 2022 to Feb. 28, 2023 discharges for hospital-level distribution statistics.

REPORT DISCLAIMER: This Health Equity Special Data Report is based on your hospital’s race and ethnicity data. If your report primarily has your patients in the “Unknown” category, it is likely because EQIC has not received your race and ethnicity data. Contact your project manager to discuss ensuring your data are received by EQIC. If your race and ethnicity data are missing, you can still review this report for your census data.
